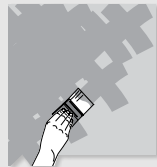


Cashmere Application Method:



Stage 1

Verify that the wall is clean and smooth. To obtain a perfectly smooth wall, apply a coat of Magic Bond and then a coat of Bondrol Super. Allow to dry and apply a coat of Supercryl Matt in the nearest shade to the Kashmir shade you chose.



Stage 2

Dip a 3" or a 4" brush in the Kashmir paint and apply a small amount of paint on the wall in crisscross movements.



Stage 3

After the coat is applied, smooth the Kashmir with a trowel, in long movements. Note areas on which a large amount of paint is loaded. If the paint tends to drip, continue leveling the paint coat. May be applied with a roller or a brush.
